The **Fifth All-Russian Student Scientific Conference with International Participation "Russia in a Global World: New Challenges and Opportunities"** will be held on March 31, 2017 in the School of International Relations, Saint-Petersburg State University. In the framework of the Conference **6 workshops** and **3 round tables** will be organized:

1. Workshop **"Russia and the Asia-Pacific Region"**
2. Workshop **"Russia and the Middle Eastern and African Countries"**
3. Workshop **"Russia and the European Countries"**
4. Workshop **"Russia and countries of Western hemisphere"**
5. Workshop **"Russia and the CIS countries"**
6. Workshop **"Russia and international organizations"**
7. Round table **"Russia and international cooperation in the sphere of sustainable development"**
8. Round table **"Russian policy in the sphere of scientific and technological development and international cooperation in the field of science, technology and innovations"**
9. Round table **"Russian Language Ambassadors and Russian foreign cultural and language policy"**

Bachelor and master students are invited to participate in the Conference¹. The abstract is limited to 2500 characters, including spaces (Times New Roman, 12) accompanied by short resume (150 words), key words (5-6) and basic personal data of the author(s) including:

- Full name and surname
- University title
- Faculty
- Professional category (bachelor/master)

Abstract deadline: **March 5, 2017**

Decisions will be announced by **12th of March** (see Vkontakte group - http://vk.com/sirmo_student_conf2017 or the website www.sir.spbu.ru)

Selected papers will be published in a book.

Full paper deadline: **April, 2017**
