

Under IP Perspective Protection for AI-generated Works in China

—also Comments on the Application of ChatGPT

Abstract: Although ChatGPT has not been available for registration for use in China, many Chinese users have used ChatGPT to generate relevant contents through proxies and the contents have been shown and greatly appreciated on social media. This leads to the question of whether the contents generated by ChatGPT has the copyright. There is no definite legal statutes about whether the works of AI are entitled to copyright in China, but there have been relevant precedents in practice. In this article, the author will discuss the properties and protection issues about AI-generated works in China and try to give suggestions and countermeasures according to related provisions of China's intellectual property law and similar public legal cases. And at the same time, this paper try to clarify the legal property of AI-generated works in the field of intellectual property by combination of the application scenarios of ChatGPT.
