The modern Olympic movement has a history of more than 100 years. Although, over the past 100 years, many people have discussed the reasons for its existence and development many times, what is its future? What is its development trend? In the early, during and late stages of the Beijing 2022 Winter Olympics, in order to promote the comprehensive and coordinated development of sports and the national strategic goal of building a sports power, sports play a unique role in socioeconomic transformation and enhance cultural competitiveness.
