



RESOLUTION
SUMMER ACADEMY OF THE BRICS YOUTH ASSEMBLY
June 22-26, 2017, Barnaul

The Summer Academy of the BRICS Youth Assembly (hereinafter - Academy) was held in Barnaul (Russian Federation) on the basis of the Altai State University (hereinafter - ASU) on June 22-26, 2017, at the initiative of the National Council of Youth and Children's Associations of Russia in the frameworks of the Program of the development of student associations of ASU in 2017 with the support of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation, the Federal Agency for Youth Affairs, the Association of Asian Universities, and the Russian Union of Student Organizations.

The main tasks of the Academy are the development of common work vectors for large national youth organizations of the BRICS countries, the creation of international project teams with the prospect of implementing joint large-scale youth projects, the establishment of scientific and educational links for interdisciplinary study of global political, economic and sociocultural processes, organization of joint laboratories, and programs of academic mobility and others. More than 100 representatives of youth organizations from the Federative Republic of Brazil, the Russian Federation, Republic of India, People's Republic of China, the Republic of South Africa and other countries took part in the work of the Academy. The guests and experts were representatives of legislative and executive authorities, the National Council of Youth and Children's Associations of Russia, the National Committee for BRICS Research, the Youth Parliament at the State Duma of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation, the Chamber of Young Legislators at the Federation Council of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation, The Alexander Gorchakov Public Diplomacy Fund, the Russian Youth Union, the Russian Union of Student Organizations, PIR Center, MGIMO University, Altai State University and others.

The organizers, participants and experts of the Academy, having discussed issues related to the creation and activities of the BRICS Youth Assembly,

- considering the importance of economic, political, scientific, educational, humanitarian and information cooperation of the BRICS countries;
- ascertaining the growth of the role of youth organizations in the development of international cooperation;
- promoting understanding, cooperation and friendship among young people of the BRICS countries;
- based on the principles of voluntary participation, equality, collegial decision-making;

- building on the Action Plan for the First Youth Summit of the BRICS 2015 and the Resolution of the Conference of the Youth Assembly of the BRICS 2016;
- having studied the experience of organizing the work of international youth organizations;
- taking into account the need to coordinate the cooperation of youth organizations of the Federative Republic of Brazil, the Russian Federation, Republic of India, People's Republic of China, the Republic of South Africa and other countries took part in the work of the Academy in the framework of the BRICS,

DECIDED:

1. To recognize as successful the holding of the Academy by ASU and the urgency of the creation of the BRICS Youth Association - the BRICS Youth Assembly.
2. To express gratitude for support in the conduct of the Academy to the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation, the Federal Agency for Youth Affairs, the National Committee for BRICS Research, The Alexander Gorchakov Public Diplomacy Fund, the Russian Youth Union, the Russian Union of Student Organizations, Center for Policy Studies, the Association of Asian Universities, state authorities of Altai Krai and local government of the city of Barnaul.
3. To consider the creation of Academy, based on the principles of pluralism, taking into account the national interests and peculiarities of the BRICS countries and the broad equal inclusion of public organizations of youth and other youth associations, necessary for realization of the tasks of the Academy, fruitful youth international cooperation and realization of joint youth projects of the BRICS countries.
4. For ASU to act as the coordinator of the creation of national contact groups from among representatives of youth and public organizations of the BRICS countries in finalization of the draft Regulations on the Youth Assembly of the BRICS (until 01.09.2017).
5. To recommend to the youth organizations the Federative Republic of Brazil, the Russian Federation, Republic of India, People's Republic of China, the Republic of South Africa - the Academy participants to provide full support and assistance in researching the Academy's materials (draft Regulations of the Youth Assembly of the BRICS, Resolution) nationwide in their countries, involving youth organizations and experts; organize discussion of materials, prepare proposals for the draft Regulations on the Youth Assembly of BRICS, send to contact groups (until 30.09.2017).
6. For ASU to summarize the proposals received from national contact groups for the establishment of the Assembly.
7. Summarized materials on the establishment of the Assembly shall be transferred to the national contact groups for sending to the relevant ministries and departments of the BRICS countries before the XIX World Festival of Youth and Students (until 10.10.2017).
8. To recommend to the National Council of Youth and Children's Associations of Russia to come up with a proposal to the organizing committee of the XIX World Festival of Youth and Students to present the initiative to create the BRICS Youth Assembly with the possibility of its establishment on the fields of the Festival in Sochi in October 2017.

9. To publish on the basis of the results of the Academy a collection of materials. To recommend the Collection of materials for replication and distribution in youth associations of BRICS countries and other countries as well.
